



TRIPS AND EVENTS

Sept. 16th- At the September Grotto meeting, Dick Garnick volunteered to become the new editor of the Cascade Caver. Afterwards, Scott Davis showed slides of his trip to Bighom Cavern in Montana and Jewel Cave, South Dakota. Rod Crawford then gave a slide presentation on cave biology and the flora and fauna they contain.

Sept. 23rd- A business meeting was held at Jim Harp's house to discuss the future of the <u>Cascade</u> <u>Caver</u>. Larry McTigue volunteered to work with and assist Dick Garnick as an additional editor of the newsletter.

Oct. 1st-2nd- A trip was made to the Trout Lake area to remove debris from the 55 ft. pit in <u>Dynamited Cave</u>. Come to the October 21st Grotto meeting to hear all about it and to sign-up for future trips the Grotto is planning.

Oct. 8th- Dick Garnick and Larry McTigue made another trip to the caves of the Chilliwack Valley of Southern British Columbia, Canada to check the level of water in a resurgence pool and dig in one of the caves.

Oct. 9th Ramsey Cave was visited by several members of the Grotto. A gate has been placed on the lower road and the land has been posted "No Trespassing". Large expensive homes in a good-sized sub-division are under construction at the present time on top of the "karst" adjacent to

Ramsey Cave. Dick Garnick suggests the Grotto contact the land-owner to see if an agreement can be reached to save the caves there and gain permission to enter them.

Oct. 21st- GROTTO MEETING-

The meeting will be held at the regular time and place. If you haven't already heard, it was incorrectly announced in the last issue as being at the Seattle Vertical Club. 


